- 3. Provide a copy of fall semester report card/grades (in lieu of, student may submit transcript through January 2020) and available SAT / ACT scores.
- 4. Provide a letter of recommendation from a high school official (teacher, coach, principal, counselor).
- 5. If any community service work has been performed, you may indicate such service by attaching a resume.
- 6. If selected to receive scholarship, please make arrangements to attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony on June 18, 2020 at The Herrera Law Firm, located at 1800 W. Commerce, San Antonio, TX 78207. Recipients will be notified within one week of the ceremony.

QUALIFICATIONS - A successful applicant must:

- 1. Have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
- 2. Be a high school senior currently enrolled in an accredited secondary school.

Qualities such as maturity, motivation, self-confidence, leadership, and personal commitment should also be addressed. Send the letter along with the application no later than May 15, 2020.

Do NOT send copies of letters sent to other admission and selection committees as substitutes for this reference letter. The letter must be constructed by the writer directly in response to the above MABA-SA Scholarship Committee criteria.

Your personal statement is a critical aspect of this application and is equivalent to a personal interview. Do not substitute personal statements addressed to other institutional admission or selection committees as they will not be accepted. General resumes will not be accepted. Include a one to two-page personal statement addressing the following elements (preferably typed, neatly handwritten is acceptable):

A. Family and Cultural Background E. Personal Hardships B. Achievements and Leadership Abilities F. Financial Need

C. Extra-curricular Activities and Personal Interest G. Any other relevant information.

D. Career and Personal goals, Personal Motto (or motto to live by)
