- 5. Provide a letter of recommendation from a high school official (teacher, coach, principal, counselor).
- 6. If any community service work has been performed, you may indicate such service by attaching a resume.
- 7. If selected to receive scholarship, please make arrangements to attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony on <u>May 15, 2024</u>. Recipients will be notified within one week of the ceremony and the location and details will provided at that time.

#### QUALIFICATIONS - A successful applicant must:
